Brief description of mandate: “supports grass roots work to help women and children in developing countries and at home escape the cycle of poverty and violence.”	
Number of meetings per year: 2 weekends per year. Arrive Friday morning and end Sunday afternoon.	
Typical time of year of meeting/s: June and October	
Location of meetings: usually in Toronto (not always)	
Amount of time required beyond committee meetings: varies depending on the level of participation one is led to assume. All members give approximately 24 to 36 hours allotted for reviewing applications for grant money every year. Communications are by email.

Specific skills needed: Christian. Ability to work within a committee and interest in women’s social justice issues.
