Dear Friend,

As a member or attender of a Meeting or Worship Group, you are part of Canadian Yearly Meeting (CYM), our family of Quakers in Canada. At whatever level you have accessed resources, or participated in CYM gatherings or committees, we invite you to explore the many ways that donations to CYM are used and the range of opportunities that are open to you and your Meeting.

If you do not already participate in Yearly Meeting committees or activities, please know you would be welcome! And if you do not yet donate to CYM, please consider this as a possibility. The work of CYM is supported in large part by donations from both Meetings and from individuals. Individual donations help us to offer most of our activities either free or at reduced cost.

Canadian Yearly Meeting in 2020 faces new challenges, and new opportunities. One result of the pandemic is a dramatic increase in the use of online technology. In many ways using the internet to access activities and resources has been a positive and exciting experience, including an increase in attendance and participation. In May 2020, the Canadian Quakers group on Facebook¹ included more than 440 Canadian Friends. And this year, many Friends from across Canada were able to 'attend' Western Half-Yearly Meeting online, some for the first time.

On the other hand, we know that something is lost when all our activities and resources are only available online, and we hope a time will come soon when we are once again able to meet face-to-face.

Of concern, as we transition to an increased online presence, are Friends for whom accessing activities and resources online presents a significant barrier. As we move forwards, we are keenly aware of the need to ensure that all Friends can fully access all available activities and resources. CYM will be offering support as we transition, to which Gini Smith, a long-time Friend, responds:

"As many of you know the ongoing communication changes have been a struggle to me. I am going to grab this golden ring which will enable me to continue my journey as an active member of Canadian Yearly Meeting."

A major challenge for CYM this year is the cancellation of our planned in-person CYM in Session for August 2020. The work of CYM Program Committee, which usually organizes the session, has been laid down until August 2020, at which time they will continue to plan for CYM 2021, in Winnipeg. In its place, an Interim Program and Support Committee (IPASC) has been formed to offer some parts of our usual CYM programming to members, attenders, and inquirers in

The "Who We Are" section of the website, provides descriptions of our beliefs, testimonies, way of worship, and Quaker history. From the section on our testimonies:

Quaker faith springs from a deeply held belief in living our lives according to our spiritual experience. Those of our spiritual insights that we call our testimonies spring from deep experience and have been a part of Quaker faith for many years. They arise out of inner convictions and challenge our normal ways of living.

With reference to our testimonies of truth and integrity, justice, equality and community, simplicity and peace:

Throughout our history, Quakers have sought to live out these values, both individually and as a community, in the ordinary detail of our lives and in the wider world – where much of our work is done through Canadian Friends Service Committee. This way of life is shaped by a deep commitment to these testimonies. It grows from a belief in the sanctity of all life and that there is something sacred in everyone. It is nourished and rooted in our practice of silent and attentive worship.

The <u>What We Do</u> section on the website provides links to other regional gatherings across Canada. It also describes the work of <u>CYM Committees</u> to guide the organization. If so led by the Spirit, there are opportunities to serve on these committees.

The <u>Resources</u> section provides recordings of Sunderland P. Gardner lectures, Bible and Quaker studies, free online courses and pamphlets, links to other Friends' groups, and information about grants and loans and the visitation program. Issues of <u>The Canadian Friend</u> are posted back to 2001, as well as the 2020 version of our <u>Organization and Procedure</u>. Excerpts are available from our <u>Faith and Practice</u>, which was created by Canadian Yearly Meeting and published in 2011 to provide support, guidance, and growth for the spiritual lives of Canadian Friends.
