In January, I sent an email asking you about your Monthly Meeting's engagement with the work of <u>Friends World</u> Committee for Consultation (FWCC).

I asked about your general familiarity with <u>World Quaker Day</u>, The Travelling Ministry Corps Corps and other programs of the Section of the Americas.

Thank you to those who responded. To those who haven't yet responded, I recognize that we have all been greatly affected by the pandemic. As we gather at our virtual CYM, I wanted to highlight some of the work we have continued through these months.

We have organized a special on-line conference for <u>Spanish speaking women on August 15</u> and have enabled others to support these connections through a <u>crowdfunding initiative</u>. As I write this, we have raised \$4320 of our \$5000 objective.

Our <u>Travelling Ministry Corps</u> have adjusted to the world as it is and this might be a unique time for your Meeting to invite a guest who might bring a view or two that are not present in your meeting.

On 5 Saturdays between <u>August 29 and October 24</u>, Young Quakers working with FWCC will be running online workshops based on Quaker Testimonies for Young Friends around the world, supported by Friends World Committee for Consultation.

We applied for and received \$30,000 to help yearly meetings with technology costs related to Covid-19. Canada Yearly Meeting applied for and received \$1,000 for this purpose!
